4. **Local Sub-divisions.** Before commencing the entries on each page insert in the space provided at the head, the name of the civil parish, ecclesiastical parish, urban or rural district, municipal ward and parliamentary division in which the buildings or dwellings which you will enter on that page are situated. Strike out such headings as are inapplicable.
